Run under BRC/BD Rules - Please note new hat rule

Please note - Hats must be tagged - Tagging will be available on the day

Riders must be 17yrs & over. Horses must be at least 4yrs old.

Any Start times on this schedule are approximate. Please check ettrickforest.co.uk on the Thursday night before the show for actual times. Please note classes may not run in numerical order

DRESSAGE (9.00am) Entry Fee EFRA Members £8 Non-Members £10 per class .

Horses competing at Prelim level cannot enter Elementary

1. **BD Introductory (Walk/Trot) Test B (2009)** Horse/Rider combination must not have won 2 Intro tests. Horses in this class may Only Enter dressage class 2a.
- 2a **Prelim 2 (2016)**. Restricted to horse/rider combination who have never been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd in any dressage competition at Prelim level or above
- 2b **Prelim 2 (2016)** Dryden Salver. Restricted to Horse/Rider combination who has not won at Prelim Level or above
3. **Prelim 18 (2002)** Restricted to Horse/Rider combination who have not won 3 Prelim classes or above
- 4 **Novice 28 (2008)**. Open
5. **Elementary 44 (2002)**. Scott-Plummer Rose Bowl. Open
6. **Pairs - Intro A (2008)** - One horse must be Intro or Prelim level the other can be any level

SHOWJUMPING Riders 17 yrs and over Entry Fee EFRA Members £8 Non-Members £10 per class Start approx 1 p.m.

7. **Beginner/Nursery (max. 65cms)** An inviting course with no fillers
8. **Nursery (max 75cm)**. Sanderson Salver. Restricted to horse/Rider combination that have not won money in any competition with jumping, or haven't been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd at Novice level and above or have not competed in any BE Event.
9. **Novice (max 85cm)**. Burns cup. Horse/rider combination not to have won at Riding Club Intermediate level and above or competed at BE 100 level and above.
10. **Intermediate (max ht 95cm)** Pat Jeffrey Memorial Trophy - Open
11. **Open (max ht 1.05m)** Stair Brown Cup
Horses entered in Classes 7 and 8 cannot enter Intermediate or Open. Horses in Intermediate & Open to be 5yrs or over.

SHOWING CLASSES Riders 17 yrs and over Entry Fee EFRA Members £8 Non-Members £10 per class Start approx 10 a.m.

There will be a rosette for the best coloured horse & best veteran horse over 15 yrs in each of the following 3 classes

12. **Hunter Type Class** - Judged as a hunter class. Horses will be ridden by the judge. There will be no jumps
13. **Family or Riding Club Horse** - will be required to jump 2 small fences max height 60cms
14. **Cobs** - Cob type horse/pony

WORKING HUNTER These classes may not run in this order. Start approx 12 Noon

15. **Baby Nursery Working Hunter. Master Quaich. Riders 17 yrs and over** For horse and rider combination who have not won any competition with jumping. Max ht fences 65cm. Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12
16. **Novice Working Hunter. Riders 17 yrs and over** Lucy Brown Cup. Horses 15hh and over and aged 4yrs and over. Restricted to horses that have not won more than two working hunter classes, or more than £20 in any class with jumping, or Been In the top three in a BE 100 class or above. Max ht fences 85cm. Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12

17. Open Working Hunter. Wares Cup. Entry fee EFRA Members £12 Non-Members £15

This is a qualifier for Courier/BHS Scotland Riding Club Working Hunter Series 2019. (Final at Blair Castle Horse Trials August 2019) Course approx. 1 metre in height.. Class will be judged in line with Sport Horse Breeding Society of GB rules. Open to horses 15hh and over. Horses must not have won more than £400 in total in any WH competitions, no more than £400 in BS winnings or have more than 45 BE points. **Riders must be 18yrs and over on 1 Jan 2019.** Hats must conform to current BRC rulebook. The first 3 will qualify for the final to be held in August 2019. If one of the first 3 has already qualified their qualification may be passed down to the fourth placed rider provided they jumped clear.

To be eligible to compete in the final at Blair riders must be a member of a British Affiliated Riding Club

Working Hunter Championship (Fun Too Salver) for 1st and 2nd placings from classes 16 and 17.

18 RoR Open In-Hand Show Series The first three go forward to the final at the RoR Goffs Uk National Championships at Aintree in August 2019 Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12

RoR eligibility : Horses must have Competition Membership and riders 15 years old on the 1st of January in the current year. For horses 3yrs and over, fillies, mares and geldings. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored. This class is a qualifier for the RoR OPEN In Hand Showing Series Final. Rosettes 1st - 6th. Prizes - 1st £30 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £20, 3rd £10, 4th £10

19 RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier This class is a qualifier for the RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Final

Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12 - Start time 9 a.m. approx and will be confirmed Eligibility : Horses must have Competition Membership and riders 15 years old on the 1st of January in the current year. For horses 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. The Series is open to AMATEURS only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series **The Judge will not ride at the qualifier but will ride in the final. The first three go forward to the final at the RoR Goffs UK National Championships at Aintree in August 2019**

Rosettes 1st - 6th. Prizes - 1st £40 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £30, 3rd £20, 4th £10

Amateur definition: An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season: Engage(d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses (for the show ring) in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard (in the current season or previous season). **Riders** must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not have received any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a show in the current or previous season. Horses must not have been ridden at a show by a rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

20 THE RoR/TBA (THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS ASSOCIATION) RETRAINED RACEHORSE CHALLENGE The first three go forward to the final at the RoR Goffs Uk Championships, Aintree in August 2019 or 2020 for shows after 1st August 2019.

Start time 10 a.m. approx & will be confirmed - Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12

RoR eligibility: Horses must have raced in GB. Horses must have Competition Membership and riders must be 15 years old on the 1st of January in the current year. Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. The judge will NOT ride. Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the judge. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.** All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time In force' The class to be judged **50%** jumping, **20%** Style while jumping and performance and **30%** awarded for show, manners and suitability to be retrained.

PHASE 1

Jumping to be judged:

8 rustic jumps 90cm to 100cm with a maximum spread of 95cm

The following points to be deducted at the end of each jumping round:

10 points to be deducted for a knock down.

15 points to be deducted for a refusal.

20 points for second refusal.

Elimination for third refusal or fall

PHASE 2

Class returns without boots and judged for an individual show/conformation. *(In some classes, at the judge's discretion, horses might be asked to do a 'show' following their jumping without leaving the ring. This is often the case with a large number in the class)*

Each horse to complete an individual show of no longer than 1 ½ minutes. Show to include the following movements:

Walk, Trot, canter showing change of leg, extended canter (gallop) halt and stand, walk off on long rein.

Total marks out of **30%** for Show, manners and suitability to be retrained.

Fences for the final at Aintree will be up to a maximum of 1.05 metre

Prizes : Rosettes 1st- 6th and Vouchers 1st to 4th place. 1st £50 plus voucher for jacket, 2nd £25, 3rd £20, 4th £10.

Veteran prize (15+): £25 voucher to be redeemed from RoR office and qualification for the Veteran Final at the RoR Goffs UK Championships at Aintree.

New Hat/Body Protector Rules

Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition

- i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) **and must have** official SEI Mark
- iv) SNELL E2001 or E2016 **and must have** official SNELL label and number
- v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) **and must have** official SAI global mark

It is the riders responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance

Body protectors must be BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label.

The ONLY exception to the requirement for a BETA Level 3 2009 purple label is that Exo Body Cages will continue to be accepted, provided they have a BETA Level 3 2000 purple label & the competitor must inform the event secretary
