Riders must be 17yrs or over,

Classes 1 to 3 - Horses must be 4 years old or over. Classes 4 & 5 Horses must be 5yrs old or over

Classes will be judged in line with Sport Horse Breeding Society of GB rules

Entry fee EFRA members £10, Non members £12

No Dogs Allowed

Class 1 Starter Class - Max height 60cms for Horse & Rider combination that have not competed in any working hunter class. This is a real baby class with inviting jumps

Class 2 Nursery – Max height 70cms Restricted to Horse & Rider combination that haven't won money in any competition with jumping, or haven't been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd at Novice level and above or haven't competed in any BE Event.

Class 3 Novice – Max height 80cms Horse & Rider combination not to have won or been placed In Open Working Hunter or Open Showjumping classes

Class 4 Intermediate – Max height 90cms Open

Class 5 Open - Max height 1.00m Open

Please note new hat/body protector rules overleaf

There will be a rosette for the best EFRA member and best Coloured horse in each class

Horses may be entered in 2 consecutive classes

Entries close on 21st June at 12 Noon

New Hat/Body Protector Rules

Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition

- i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) **and must have** official SEI Mark
- iv) SNELL E2001 or E2016 **and must have** official SNELL label and number
- v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) **and must have** official SAI global mark

It is the riders responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance

Body protectors must be BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label.

The ONLY exception to the requirement for a BETA Level 3 2009 purple label is that Exo Body Cages will continue to be accepted, provided they have a BETA Level 3 2000 purple label & the competitor must inform the event secretary
