By entering you agree to adhere to the COVID 19 restrictions set by the Club and Venue as detailed below. Anyone found to not be abiding by these Rules will be asked to leave and take NO further part in the Winter Leagues Series.

ENTRIES:

Online Entries only — if you are unable to enter on Clubentries then please pm or email the contact on the schedule for BACS details.

Only **one** helper per horse, no spectators permitted. Name, Address and Phone Number of your helper must be provided on ClubEntries at time of entry. These will be kept for 21 days for Track and Trace purposes. Should your helper change after entries have been submitted then updated details must be sent to the event organiser, Krista Ainslie, (Khill053@hotmail.com) and club Covid Officer, Lyndsay Allan, (lallan@britishhorseracing.com) no later than 6pm the night before the event.

For the first event, you only permitted to enter one jumping class per horse.

DURING THE EVENT

Competitors will be given a warm up time and a competition time — please do not arrive earlier than 45 minutes before your published warm up time.

Lorries/trailers will be parked 3m apart by a parking official as space is at a premium at Dryden. Tying up outside lorries/trailers is not permitted. Any cars **must** be parked in the small layby immediately on the left when leaving the A7 at Dryden and **not** in the main or top yard.

Please maintain social distancing (2 metres) at all times. EFRA strongly recommends the use of face coverings, with the exception of when mounted.

Numbers will not be issued. If you have a number bib you will be asked to print/write out your own number. Bridle or saddle cloth numbers may also be worn

You will be given a warm up time and a competitive round time. Do not attempt to enter the warm up arena before your allocated time.

You will be allocated a “competition jumping slot”. During this time you will enter the indoor arena and have some time to acquaint yourself with the course. You will then commence your first round, which will count as a clear round. After a short breather, you will then commence your competitive round, before then jumping the “jump off” course. You will then leave the indoor arena and the next competitor will be allowed to enter.

The exception to this is the training class, as there will be no jump off round.

The number of people in the Warm Up Ring at one time must not exceed five. This number includes riders and officials.

Riders must leave the premises immediately after they have competed — no waiting or stopping to chat please

There will be no secretary's office and no scoreboard. The green cabin can be used to access the toilet facilities. Please follow Stable Life's rules regarding this. Scores and results will be available online by midnight on day of competition. Anyone wishing to have their rosette sent to them should bring a SAE (A5 size) and leave in the box/bin provided. Rosettes and prizes (vouchers) shall be posted out in due course. Any unused envelopes will be returned at the end of the SJ League.

Social Distancing (2 metres) must be adhered to by all attendees at all times. Please adhere to instructions given by the Organiser(s), Committee Members and the Covid Officer. We are all trying our best to make this safe and successful!!

Times will be available on the EFRA website and Facebook on the Friday before the competition.

Class Restrictions:

Class 1 – Open to inexperienced horses/riders as a training round. Judged as Clear Round with help given if wanted.

Class 2 – Restricted to horse/rider combinations that have not won any money at any competition with jumping or won any class at Novice level (80cm) or above. Horses jump two rounds and penalties are for knockdowns/refusals.

Class 3 – Restricted to horse/rider combination who have not been placed at any BE event or won more than £20 in any class with jumping.

Classes 4&5 - Open.

Horse and rider combinations can stay at the same level throughout the Winter League.

Entries close on the Wednesday 6 p.m. before the competition date. Withdrawals before closing date please. No refunds after close of entries. Event Secretary: Krista Ainslie – khill053@hotmail.com.
