Run under BRC Rules

Minimum age of horses for classes 1 - 4 is 4yrs and 5 years for classes 5 - 7.

Sunday 10th October 2021 (1 of 4)

Horse and rider combinations can stay at the same level throughout the Winter League

Class 1a TRAINING CLASS - 55-60CMS - £10: Open to inexperienced horses/riders as a training round. Judged as a clear round, with help/guidance given if wanted. One round, with the option of jumping a second round if you wish.

Class 1b STARTER CLASS - MAX 60CMS - £10: Open to inexperienced horses/riders as a competition. Restricted to combinations who have not been placed 1st - 3rd at any jumping competition at 70cms and above on more than 2 occasions. Combinations will jump one round, with penalties for knockdowns/refusals, then jump a second shortened round which have a generous optimum time.

Class 2 NURSERY - MAX 70CMS - £10: Restricted to combinations who have not been placed 1st - 3rd at any jumping competition at 80cms and above on more than 2 occasions. Combinations will jump one round, with penalties for knockdowns/refusals, then jump a second shortened round which will also be judged against an optimum time.

Class 3 CLEAR ROUND 70CMS - £5: For Novice class entries only.

Class 4 NOVICE - MAX 80CMS - £10 - Restricted to combinations who have not been placed 1st - 3rd at any jumping competition at 90cms and above on more than 2 occasions. Combinations will jump one round and then jump a second round over a timed shorter course.

Class 5 CLEAR ROUND 80CMS - £5 - For Intermediate and Open horses only.

Class 6 INTERMEDIATE - MAX 90CMS - £10 - Open

Class 7 OPEN - MAX 100CMS - £10 - Open

By entering, the attendees acknowledge and agree that although EFRA & Stable Life have taken every precaution and followed Government Guidance, it is impossible to eliminate all risk and there remains the potential for unintended transmission of COVID-19. All those attending must play their part in minimising the risk to themselves and others by complying with the Government Guidelines as well as any on site instructions and signage. EFRA have the right to refuse entry or request departure from the event should there be any breach of the Covid-19 protocols put in place.

General information

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto parking area. Take all litter home with you. All riders and helpers must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Rudeness will not be tolerated.

Hats must be worn at all times when mounted and must comply to the current BETA Standards (see below). Hair must be above the collar and long hair secured with a hairnet.

Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended or tied to the outside of trailers/lorries
Social distancing must be adhered to at all times

Ettrick Forest Riders Association (EFRA) Privacy Statement

Any information given on entering will only be used for the purposes of this competition and will not be passed on to any third party.

Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition

- i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark
- ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark
- iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) **and must have** official SEI Mark
- iv) SNELL E2001 **and must have** official SNELL label and number
- v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) **and must have** official SAI global mark

It is the riders responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance

Body protectors must be BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label.

The ONLY exception to the requirement for a BETA Level 3 2009 purple label is that Exo Body Cages will continue to be accepted, provided they have a BETA Level 3 2000 purple label & the competitor must inform the event secretary
