CLASS RESTRICTIONS

Class 1 – Open to inexperienced horses/riders as a training round. Judged as Clear Round with help given if wanted

Class 2 – Restricted to horses that have not won any money at any competition with jumping or won any class at Novice level or above. Horses jump two rounds and penalties are for knockdowns/refusals and the second round is given marks for style

Class 2A – December only - teams of two are firstly judged on their fancy dress then jump the course passing a baton to their partner to begin. This will run over the Nursery course and will be timed

Class 3. – At nursery height for **Novice** class entries only

Class 4 – Restricted to horses who have not been placed at any BE event or won more than £20 in any class with jumping

Classes 5 – At novice height for **Intermediate and Open** horses only

Classes 6 & 7 - Open

Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition

- i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark
- ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark
- iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) **and must have** official SEI Mark
- iv) SNELL E2001 **and must have** official SNELL label and number
- v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) **and must have** official SAI global mark

It is the riders responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance
Body protectors must be BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2000 or 2009 label

Paper entries MUST BE accompanied by payment at time of entry

Please note - Entries will no longer be taken on the day and will close on the Thursday 12 noon prior to the competition. However any competitor who feels they have gone well and would like to enter the next class up may do so at the competition. These will be limited to 4 competitors per class on a first come first served basis. Classes will not start before their designated time

Approx. class times will be posted on EFRA's website and on Facebook on Friday before competition

Points will be awarded and the horse/rider combinations with most points will be presented medals and trophies at the Annual Gettogether. There must be two or more competitors in class for points to be awarded

Horse and Rider combinations can stay at the same level throughout the Winter League Showjumping

Previous Nursery, Novice and Intermediate league winners may continue to compete at their winning level but will not be eligible for league points. Open winners may continue to contest the Open League

Please be considerate when parking. Trailers in lay-bye if possible to allow lorries to park in yard
